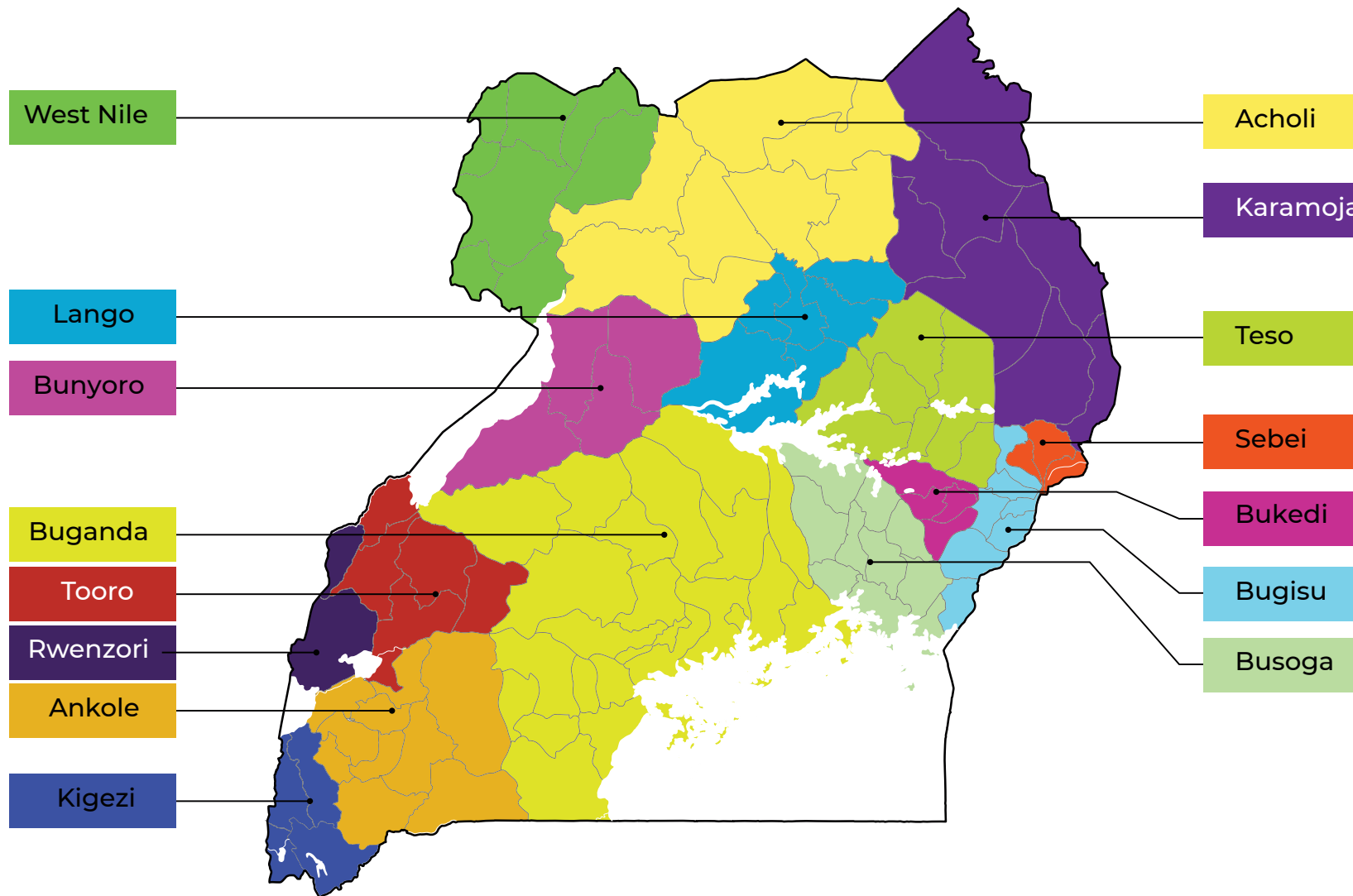

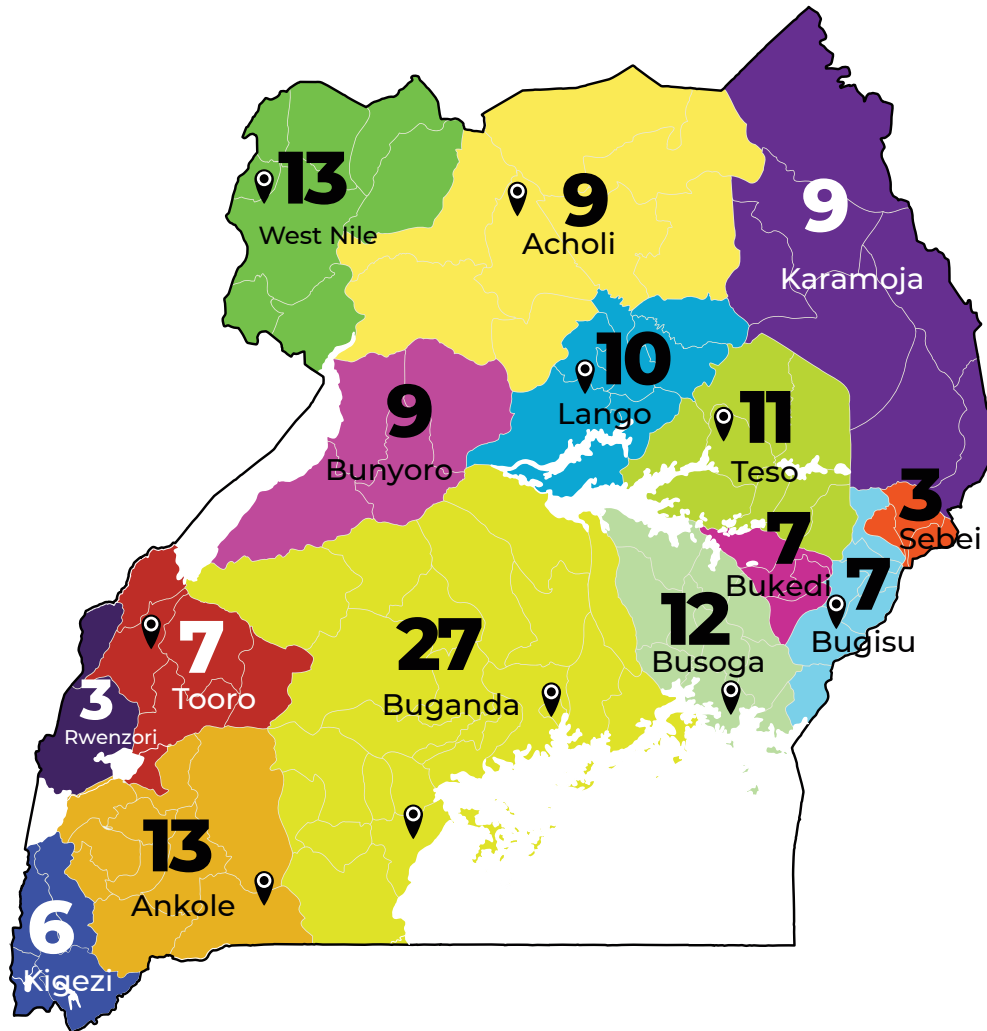

**Figure 1.2: Map of Uganda showing number of districts and cities by region as at December 31, 2020**

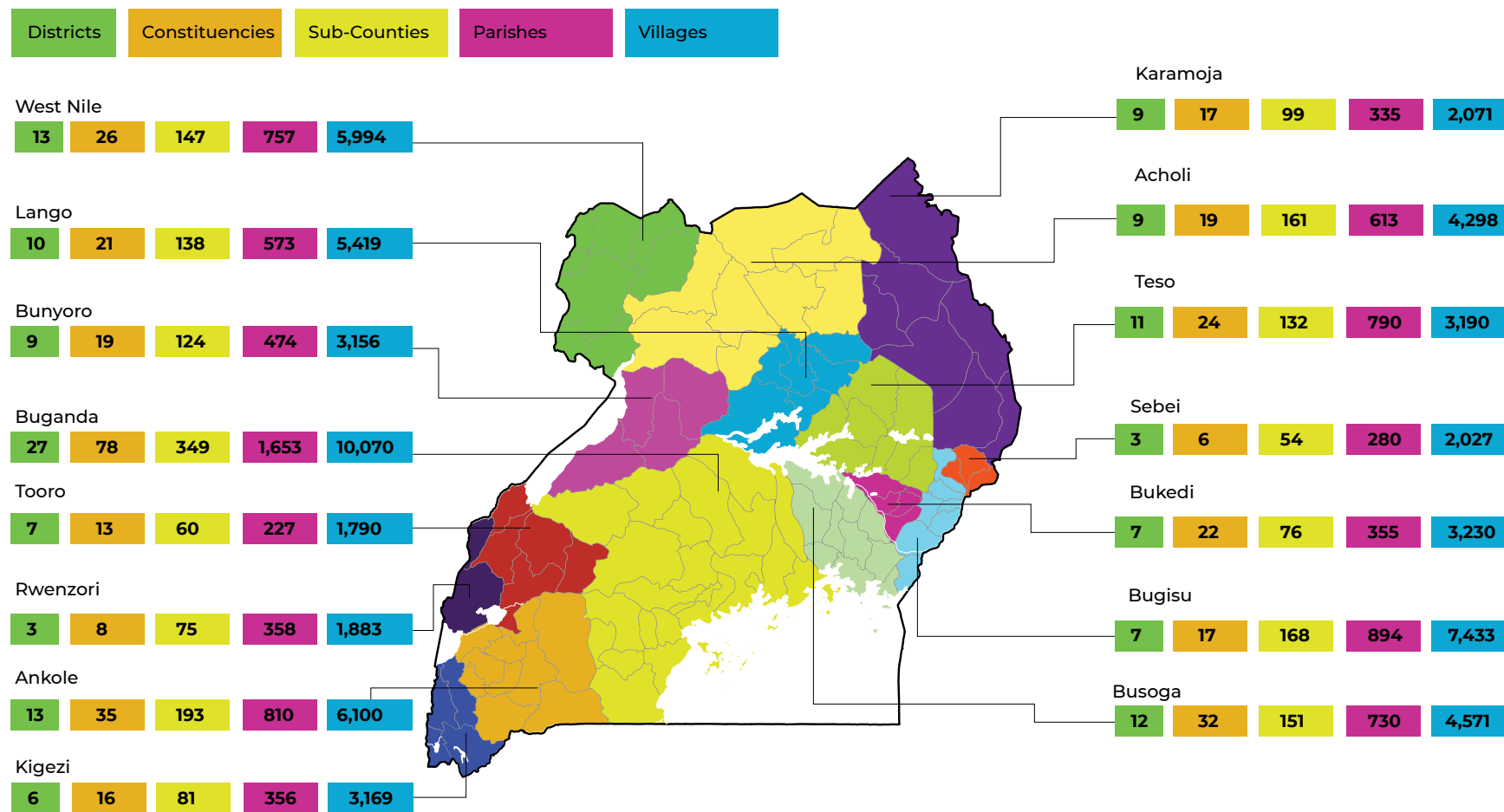

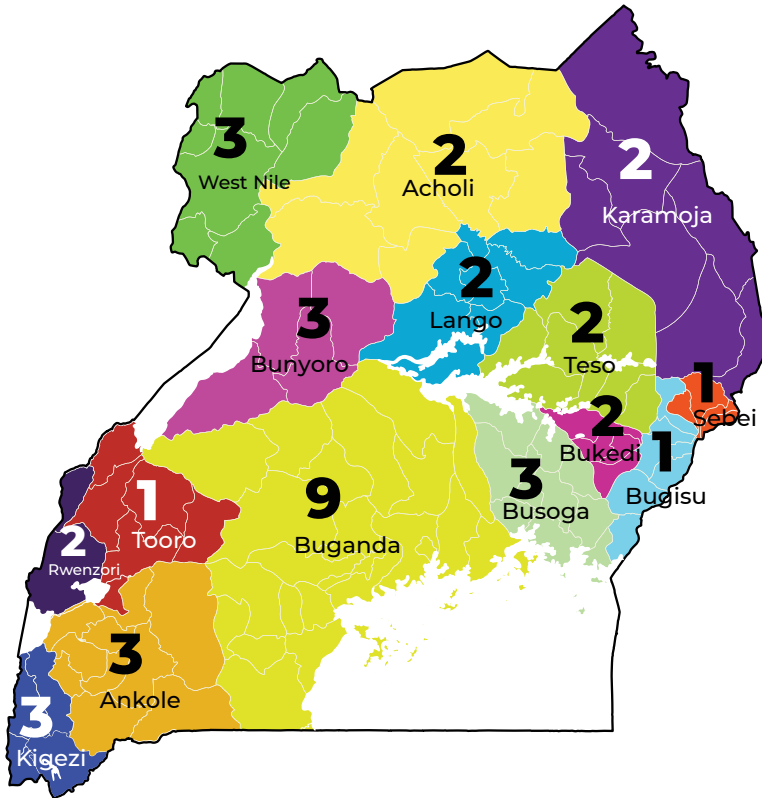

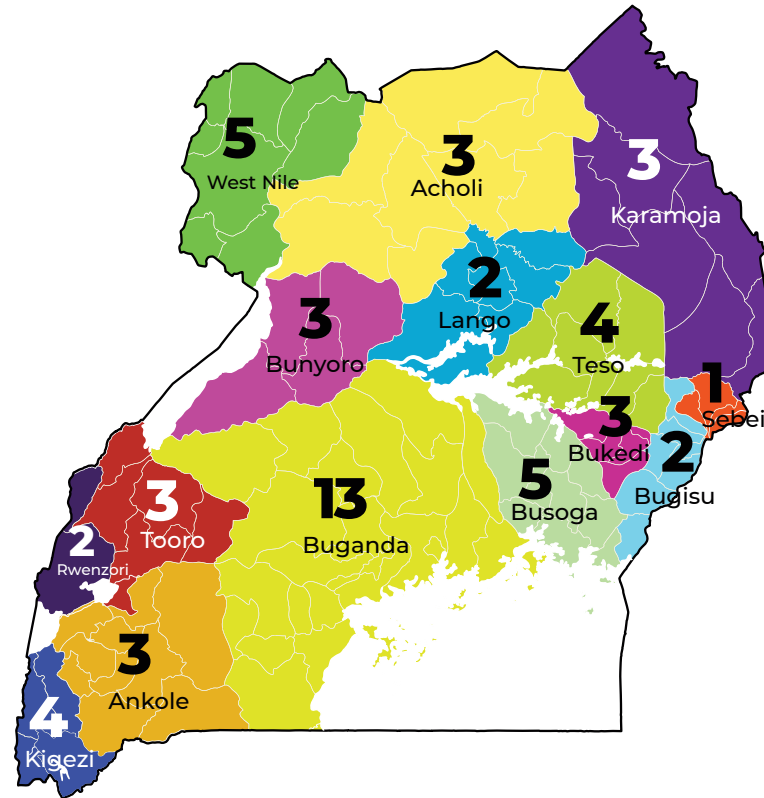
**The changing district map of Uganda by election cycle**

Figure 2.2: Districts of Uganda as at June 30, 2001

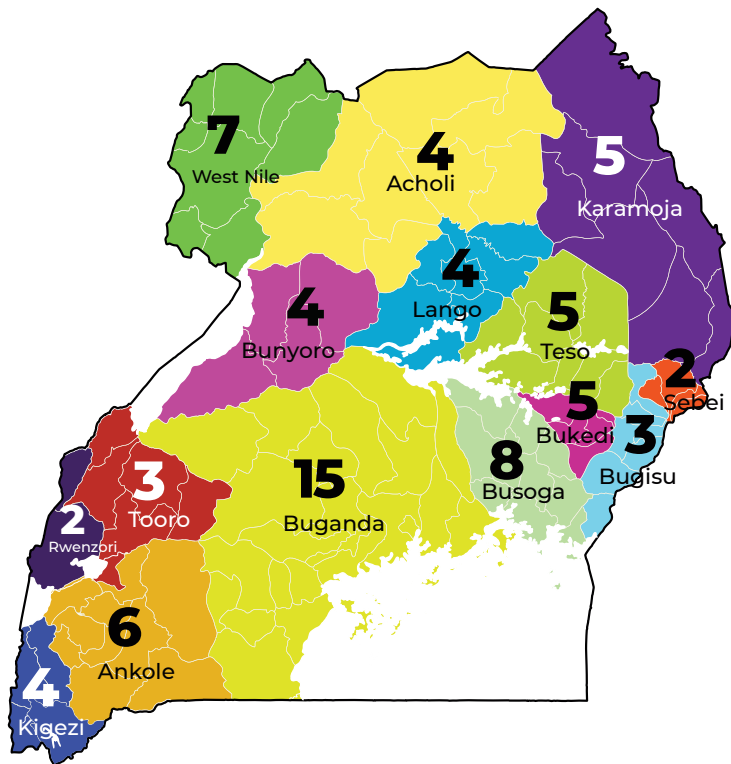

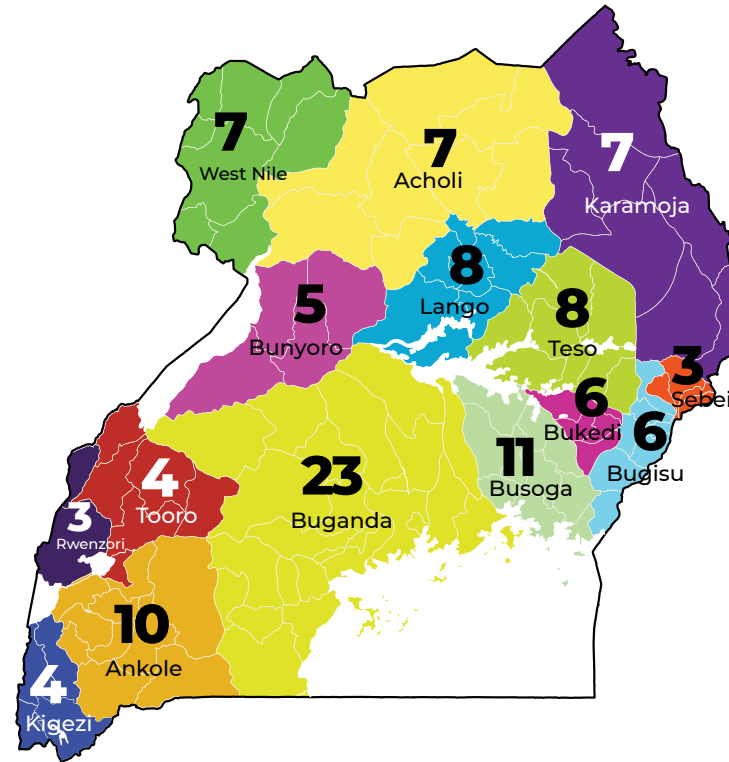
The changing district map of Uganda by election cycle

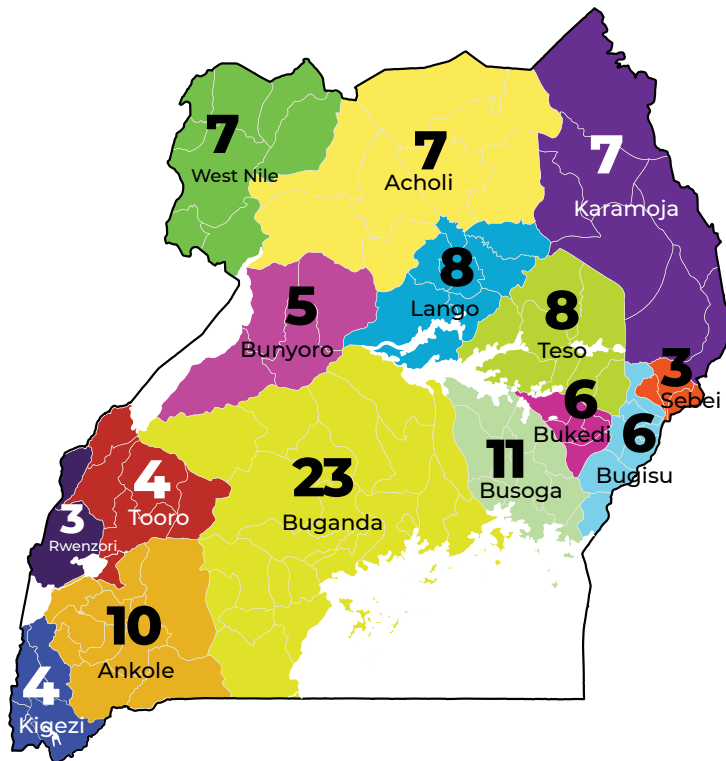
Figure 2.4: Districts of Uganda as at June 30, 2011

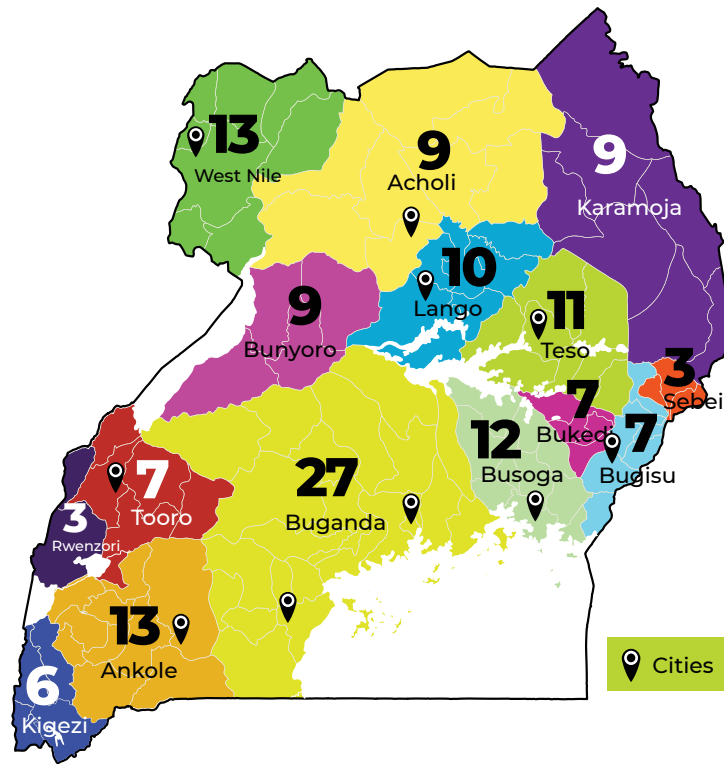
The changing district map of Uganda by election cycle

Figure 2.6: Districts of Uganda as at June 30, 2020



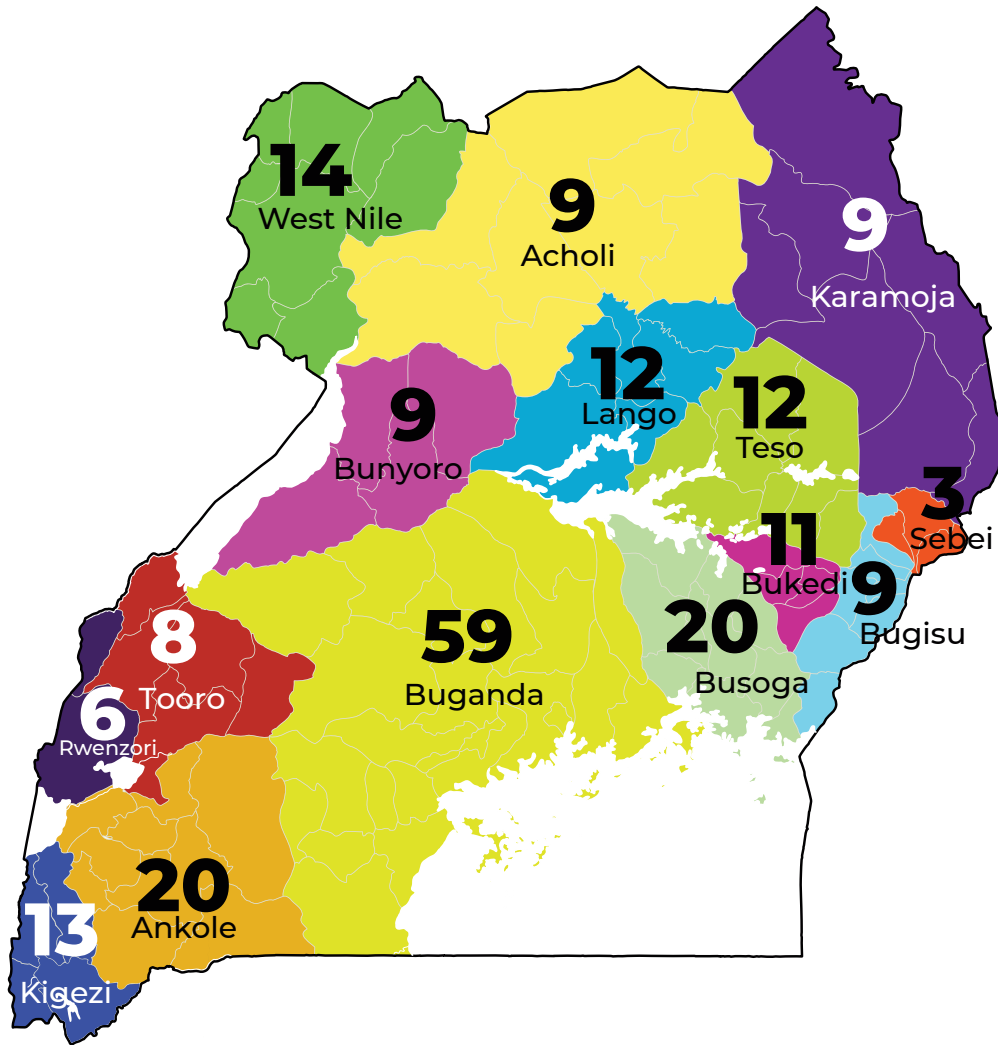

Figure 3.1 : Map of Uganda showing constituencies for directly elected members of parliament at the time of adoption of the 1995 constitution

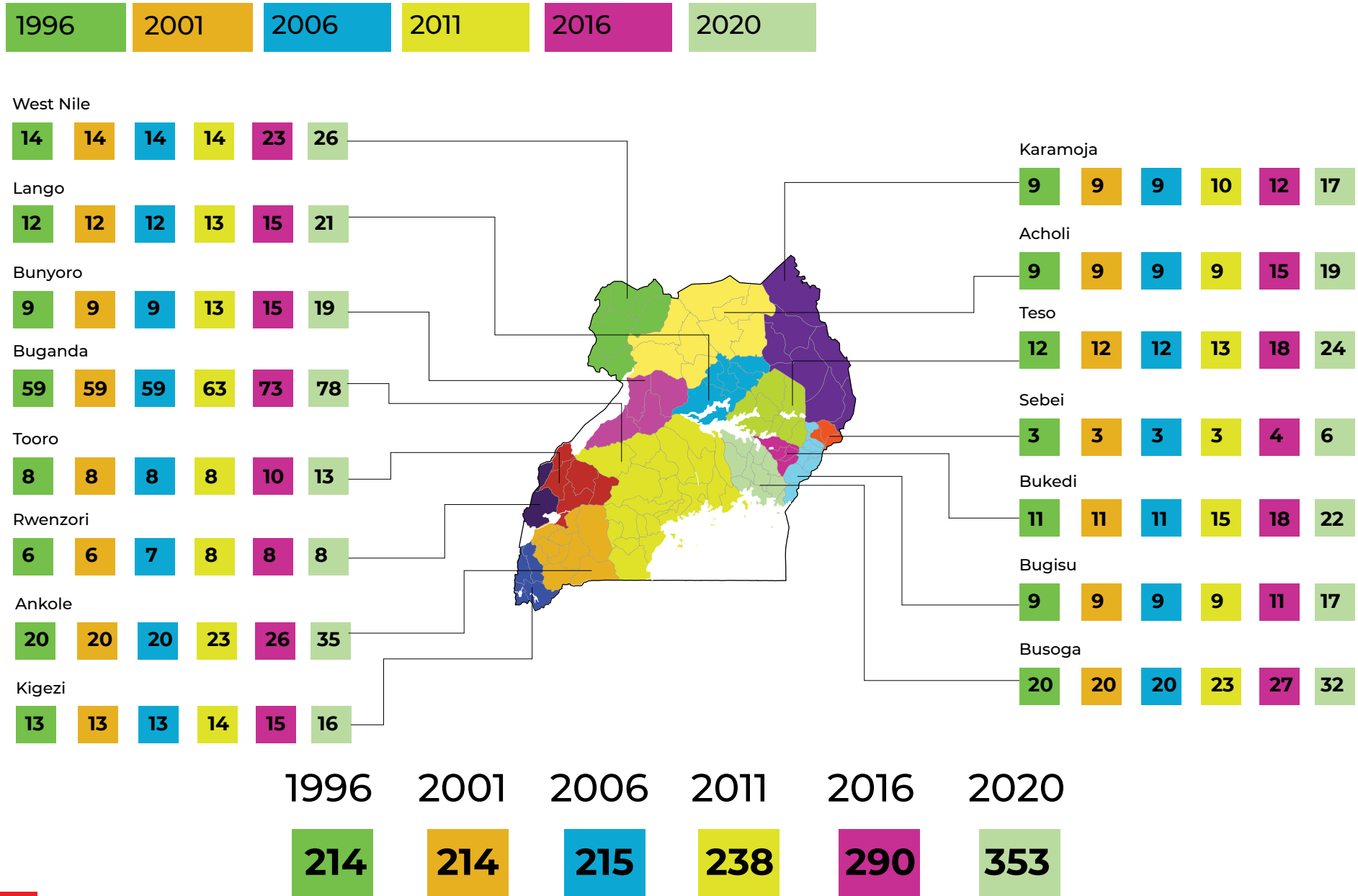

**Figure 3.2: Constituencies map of Uganda by election cycle since 1996 by region**





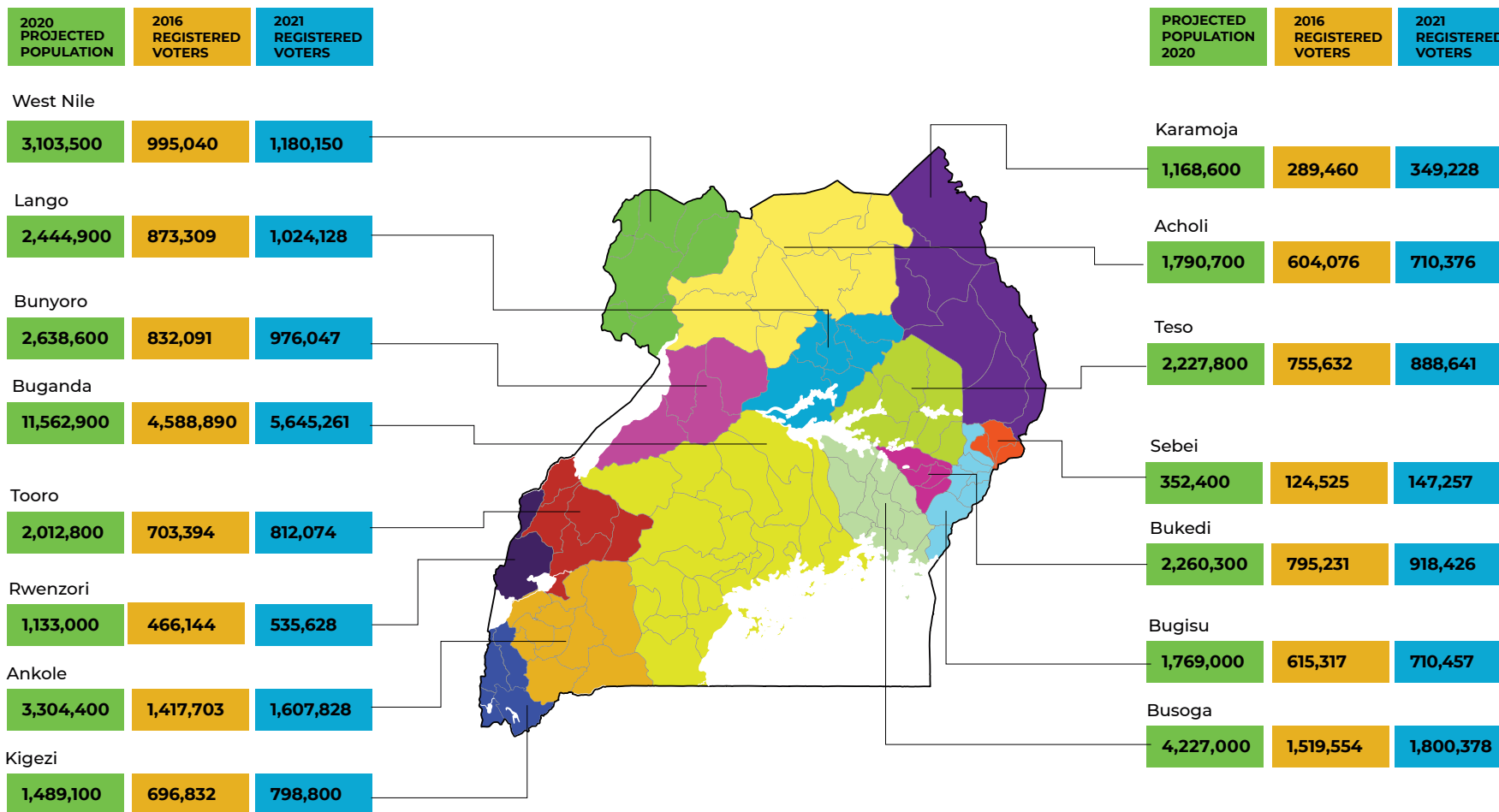

**Figure 4.1: Projected population for 2020 and the distribution of registered voters for 2016 and 2021 by region**



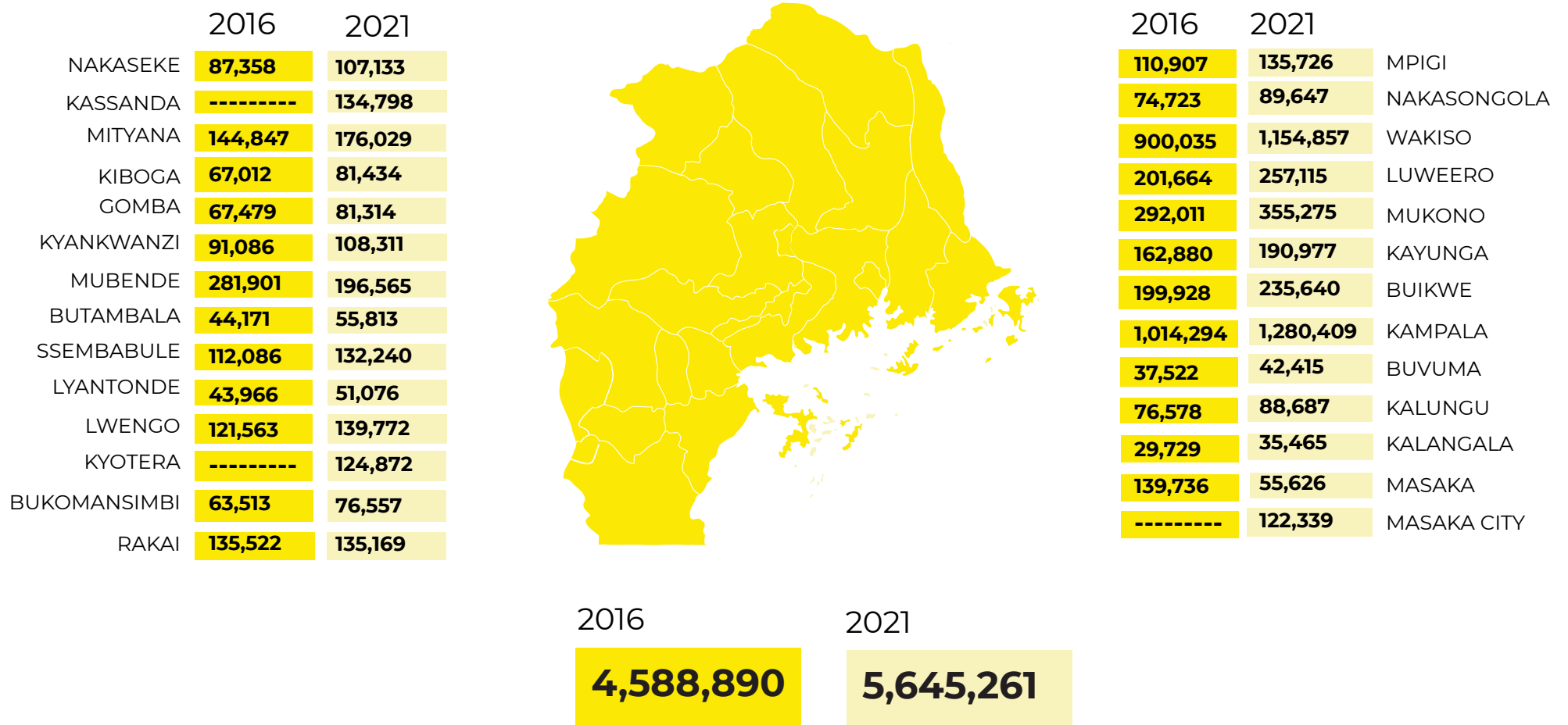

Figure 4.3: Distribution of registered voters in Acholi for 2016 and 2021

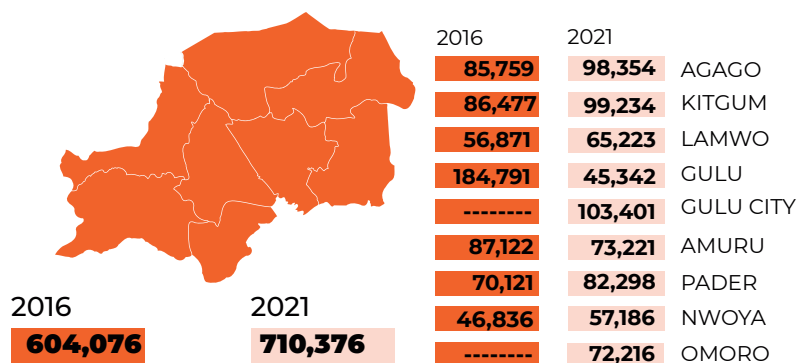


Figure 4.4: Distribution of registered voters in Ankole for 2016 and 2021

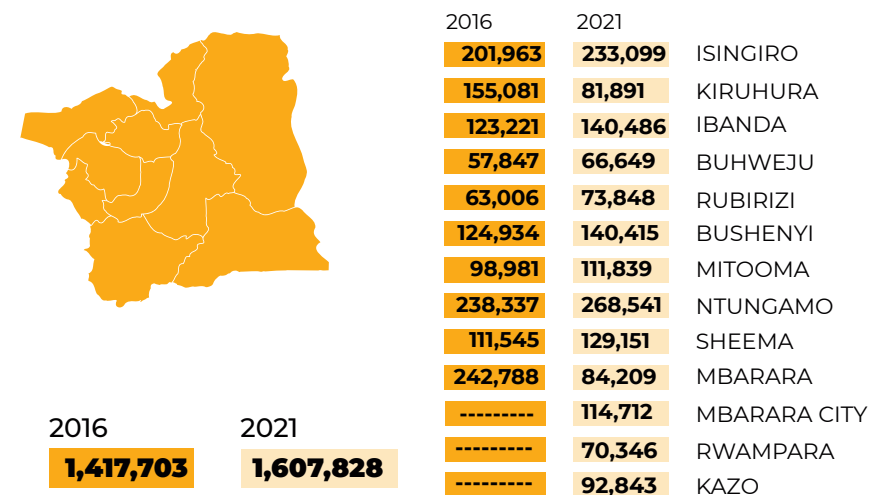


Figure 4.5: Distribution of registered voters in Bugisu for 2016 and 2021

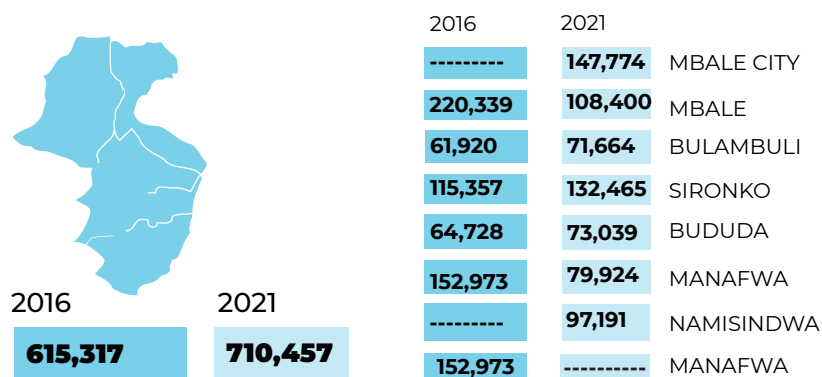
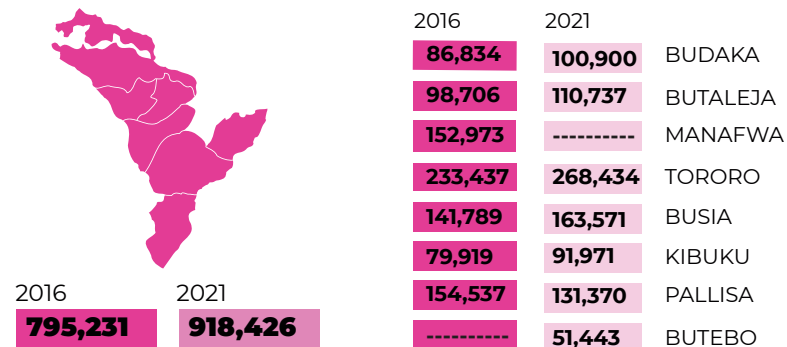


Figure 4.6: Distribution of registered voters in Bukedi for 2016 and 2021

Figure 4.7: Distribution of registered voters in Bunyoro for 2016 and 2021

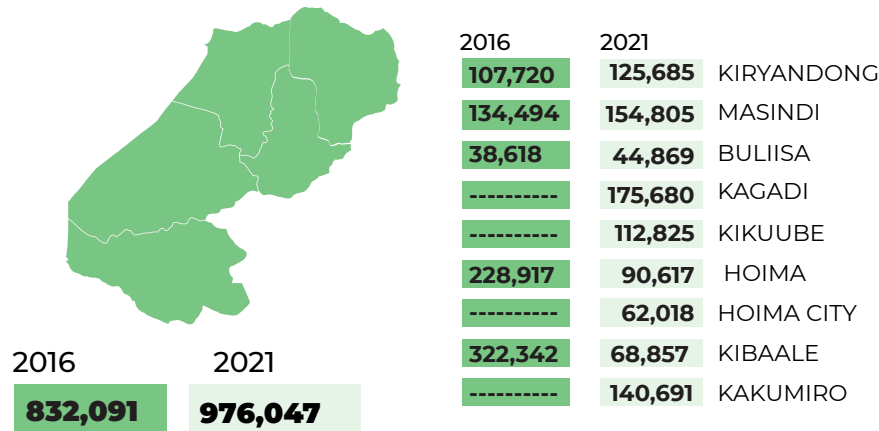


Figure 4.8: Distribution of registered voters in Busoga for 2016 and 2021

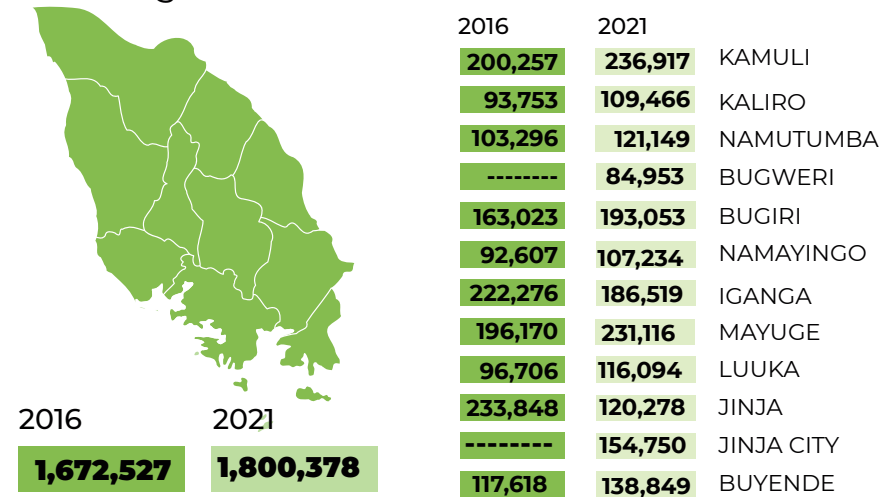


Figure 4.9: Distribution of registered voters in Karamoja for 2016 and 2021

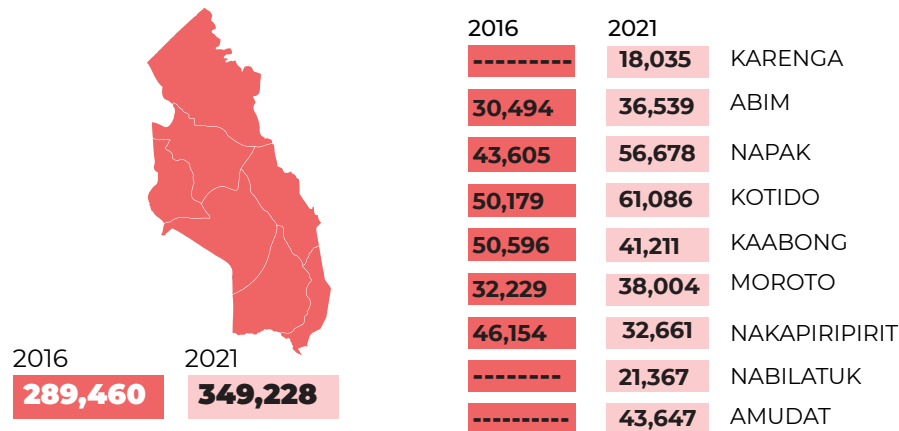
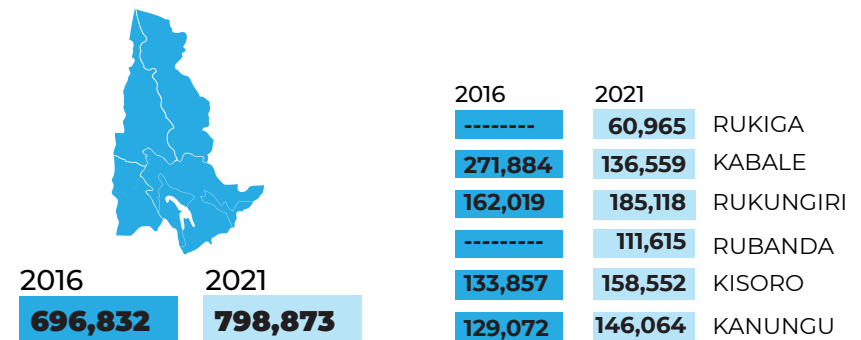


Figure 4.10: Distribution of registered voters in Kigezi for 2016 and 2021

Figure 4.11: Distribution of registered voters in Lango for 2016 and 2021

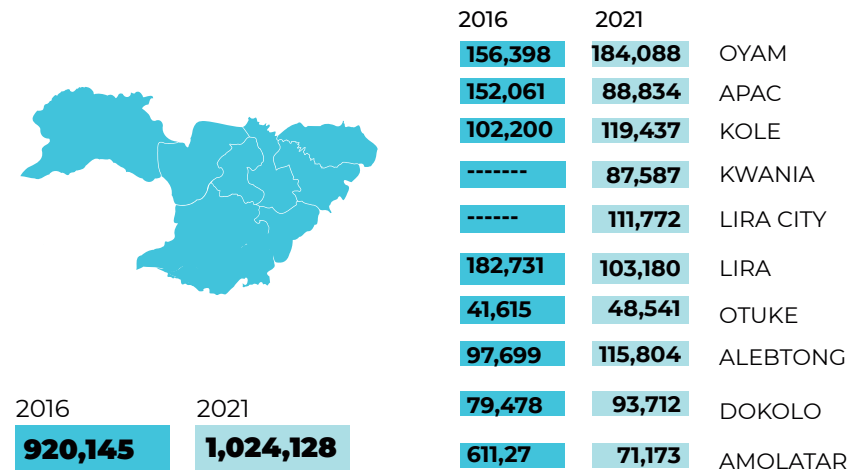


Figure 4.13: Distribution of registered voters in Sebei for 2016 and 2021

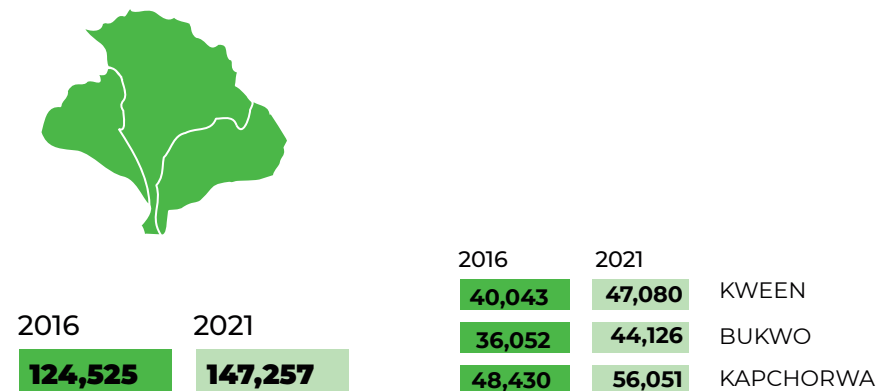


Figure 4.12: Distribution of registered voters in Rwenzori for 2016 and 2021

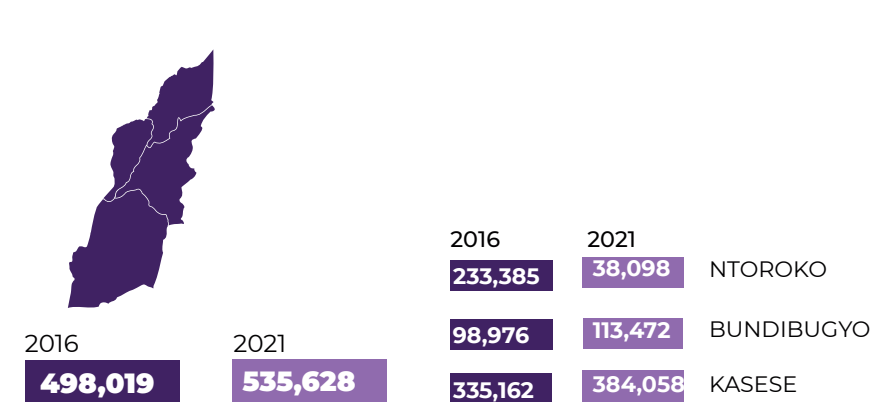
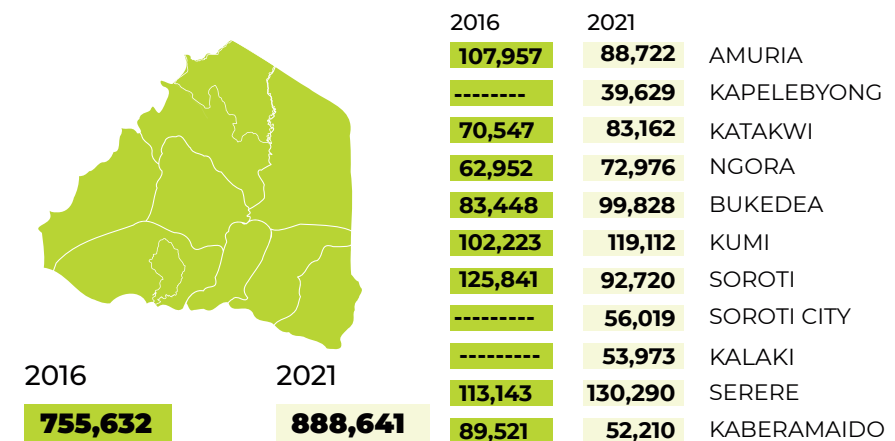


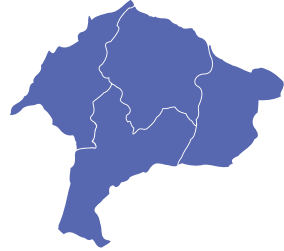
Figure 4.14: Distribution of registered voters in Teso for 2016 and 2021





**Distribution of registered voters for 2016 and 2021 disaggregated by region**

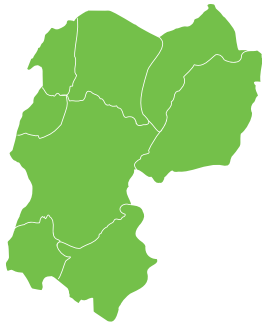
Figure 4.15: Distribution of registered voters in Tooro for 2016 and 2021.

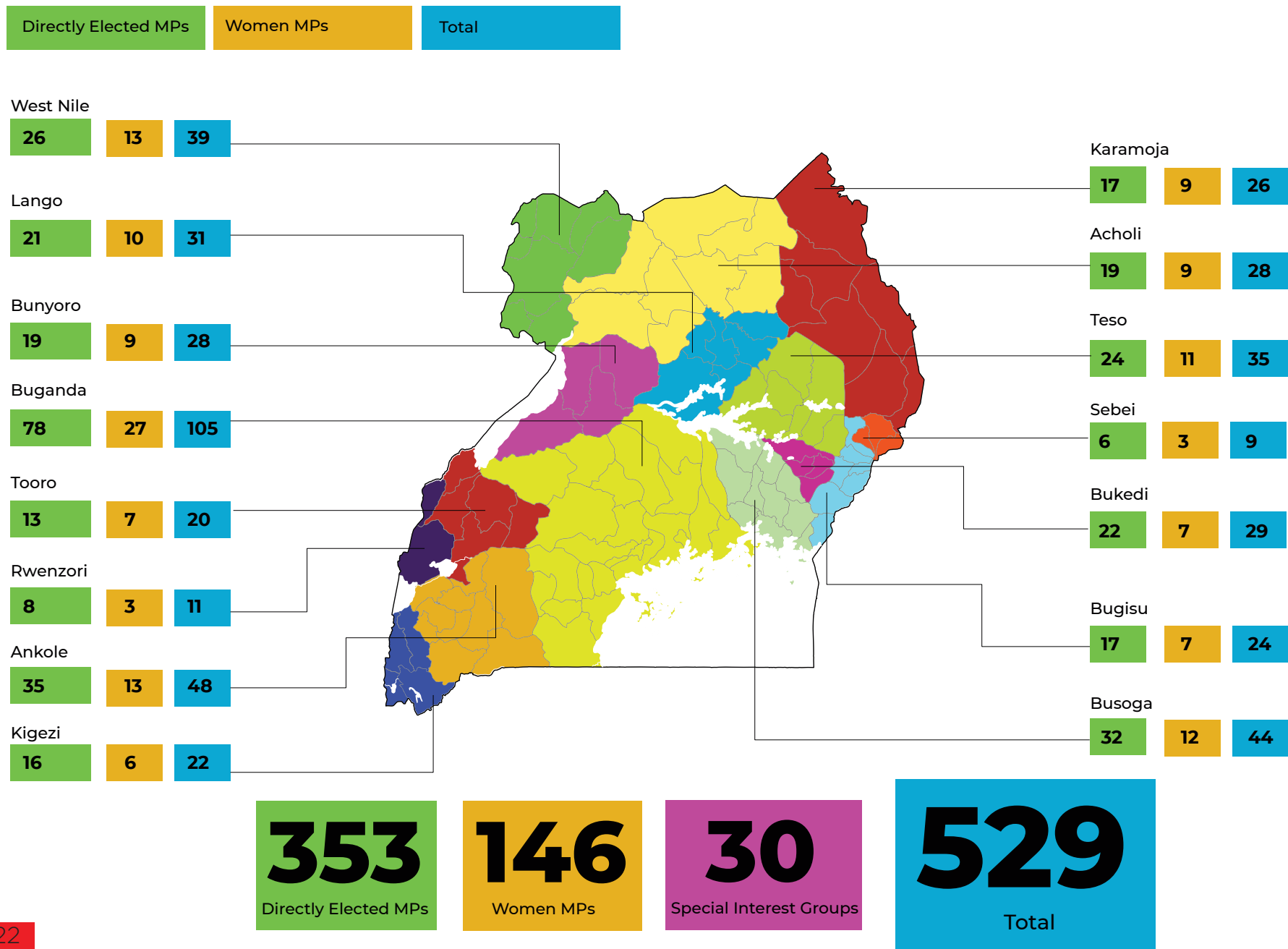




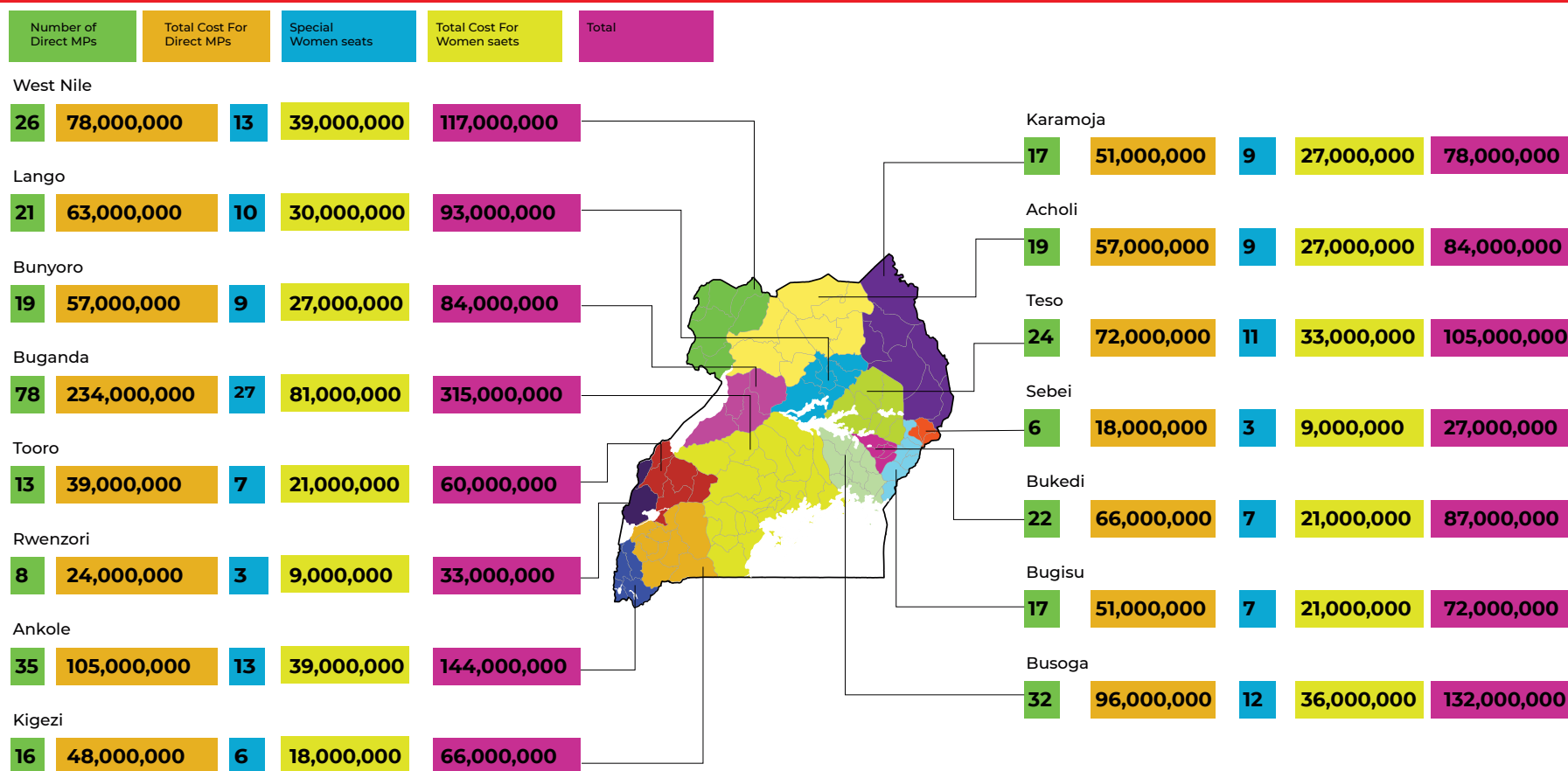

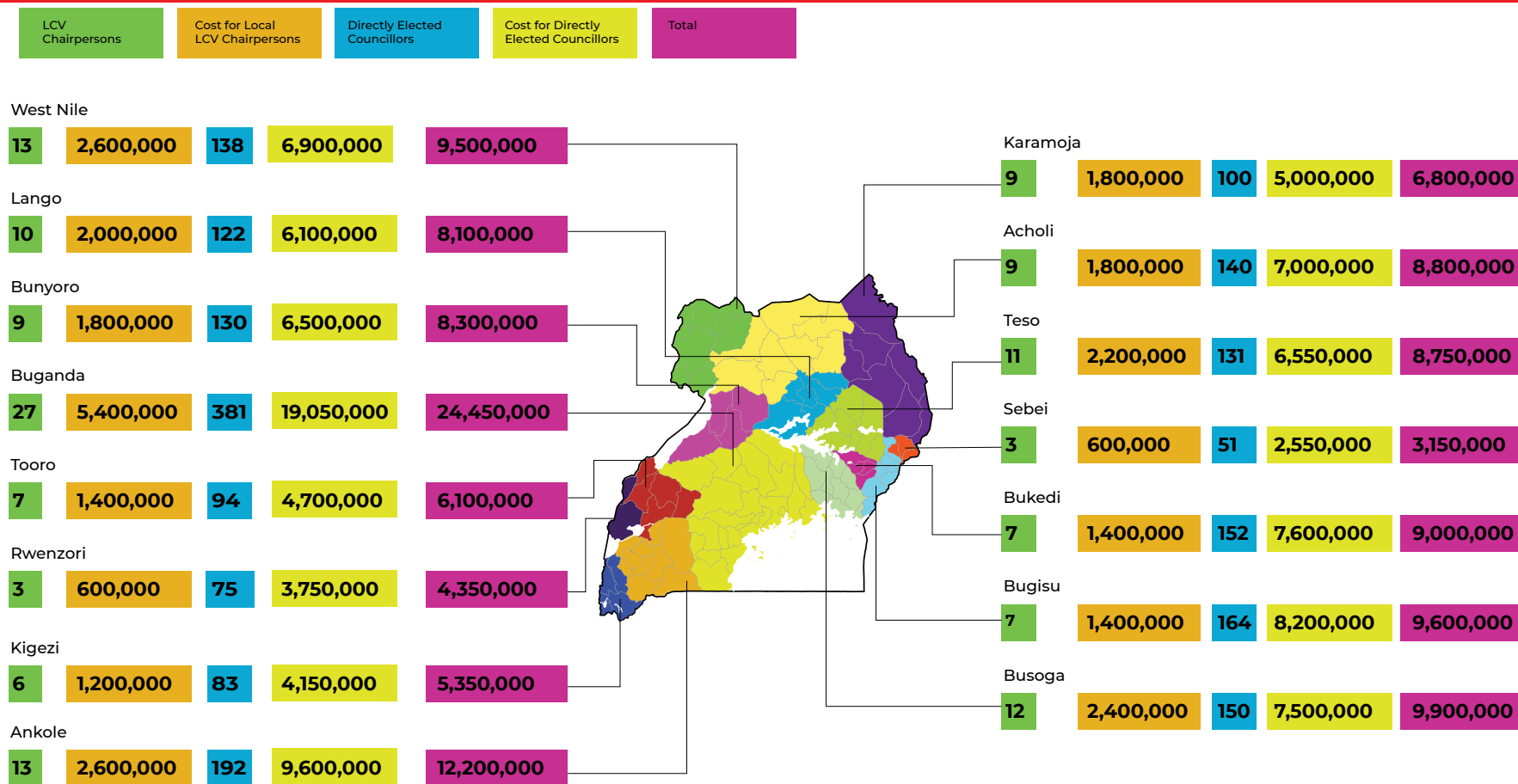

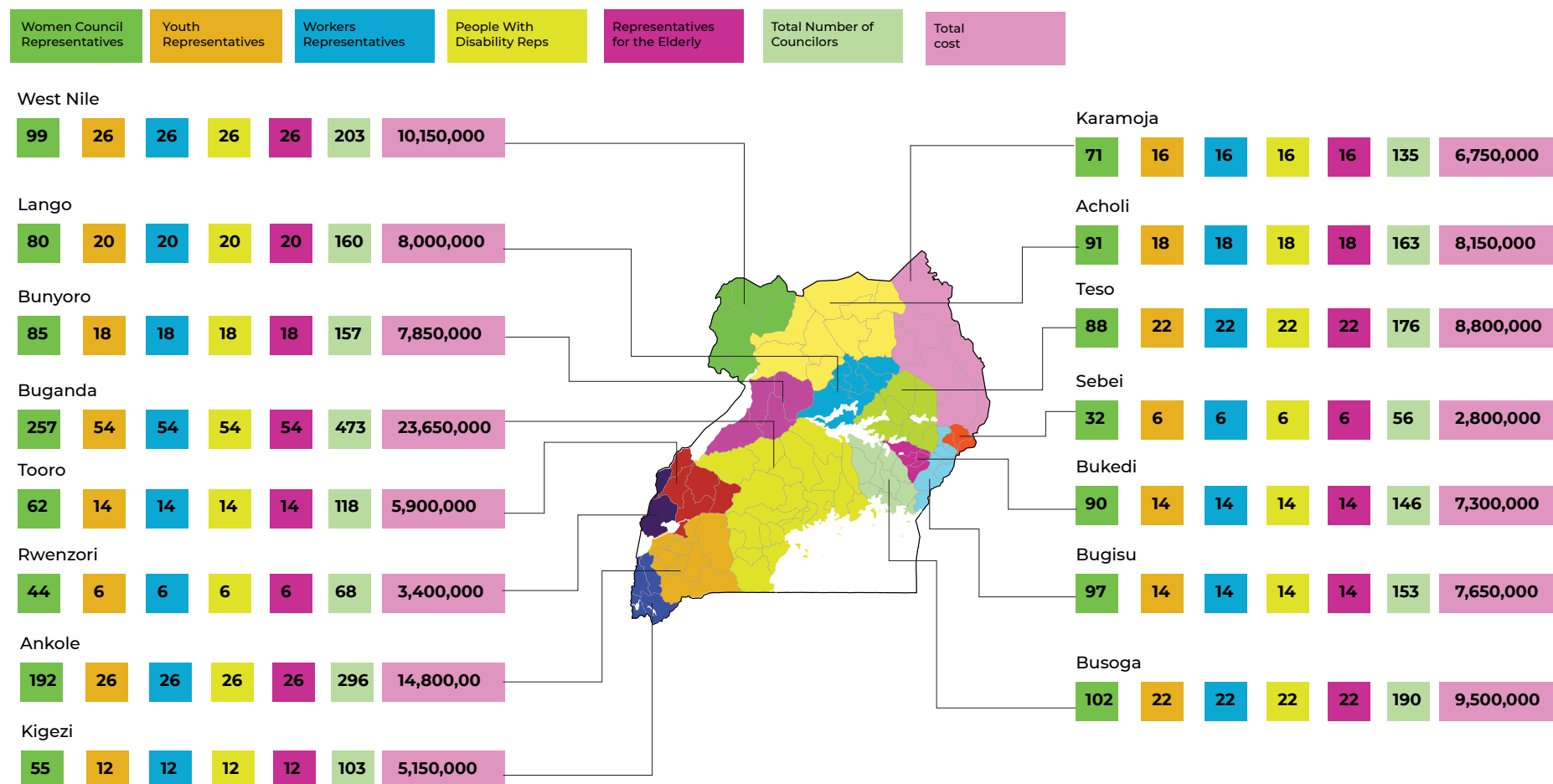

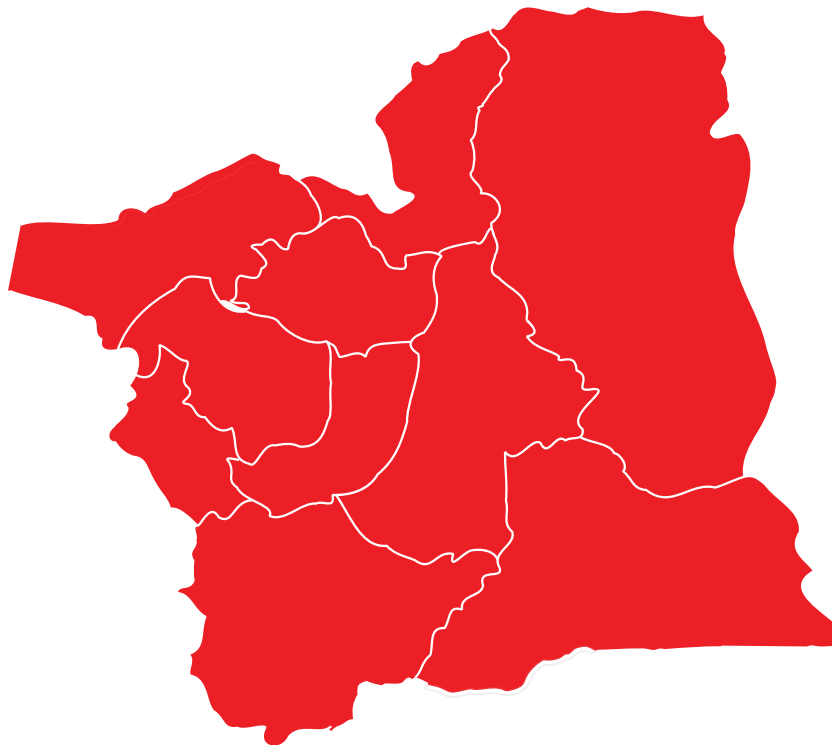

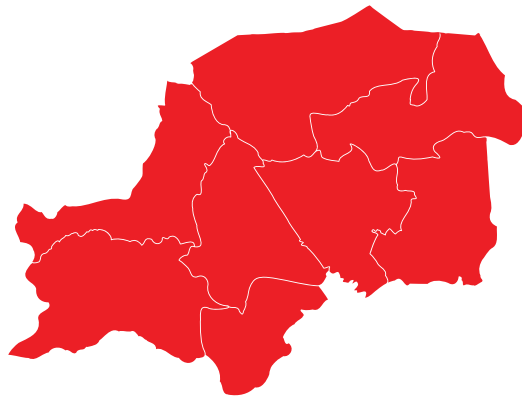
Figure 6.1: Directly elected incumbent MPs in Ankole who voted for removal of age limit and ran for re-election in 2021.

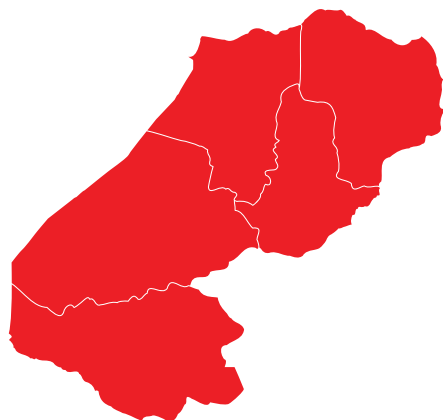

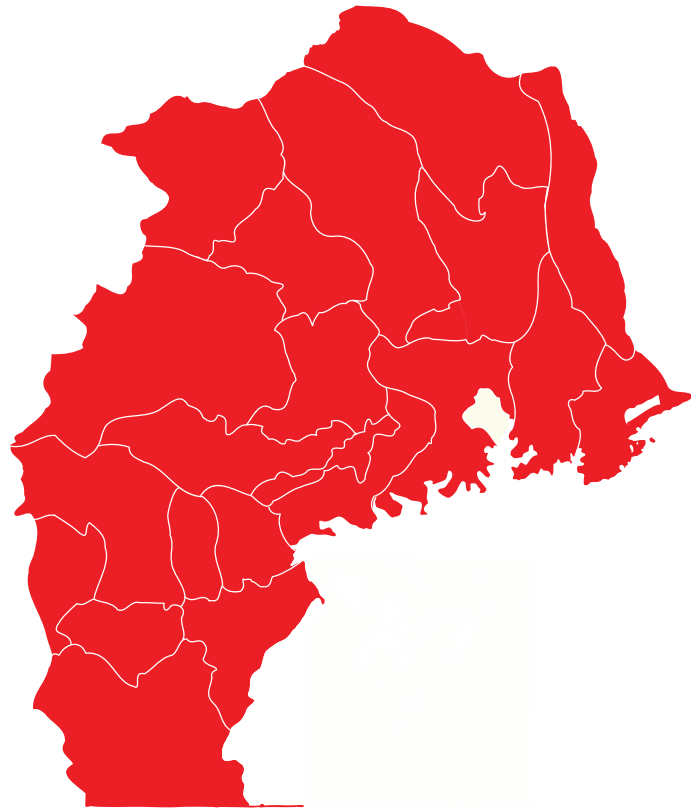
Figure 6.5: Directly elected incumbent MPs in Bukedi who voted for removal of age limit and ran for re-election in 2021.

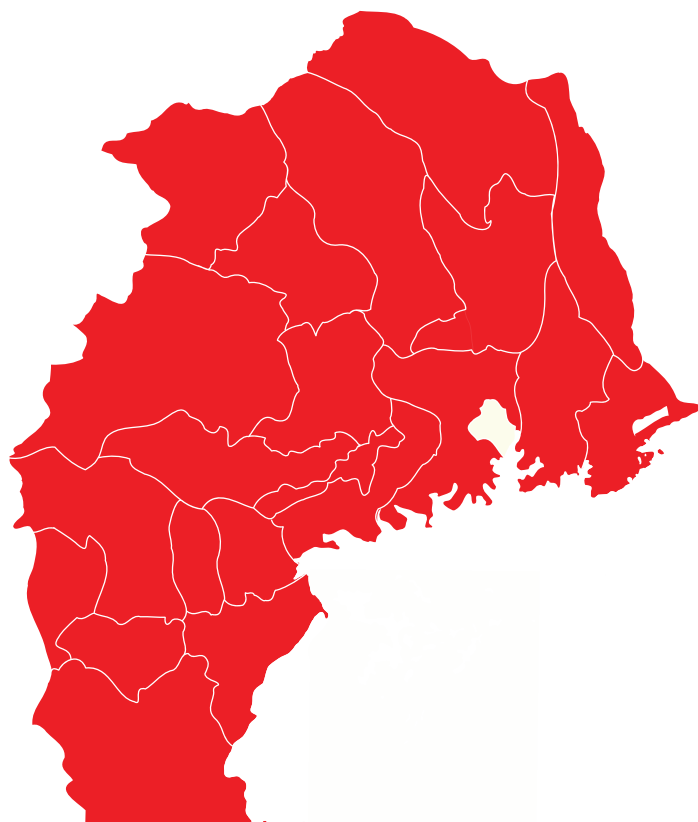

Figure 6.7: Directly elected MPs in Buganda who voted for the removal of age-limit and ran for re-election.

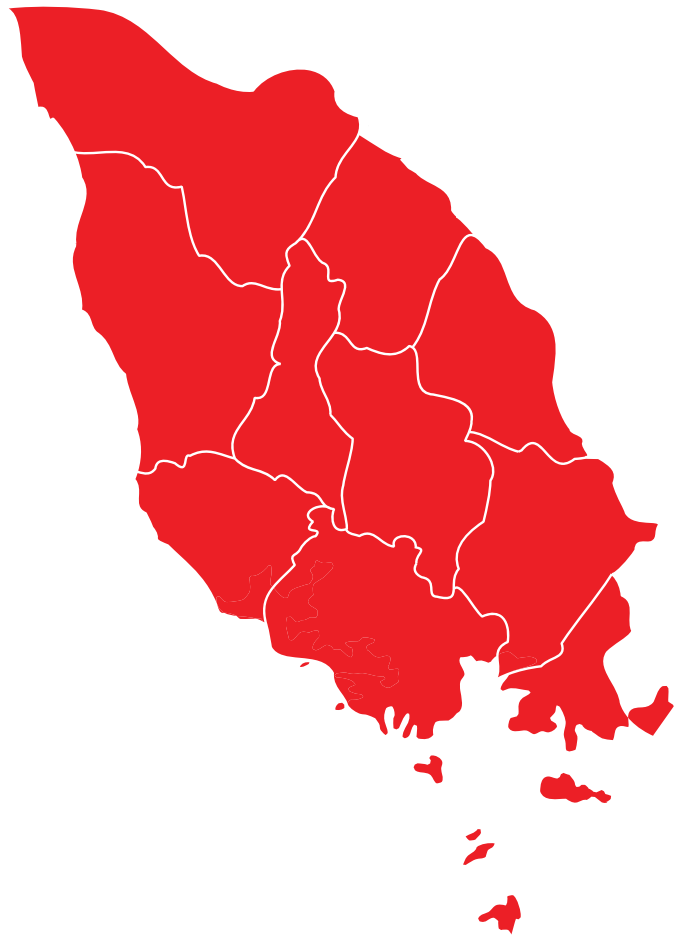

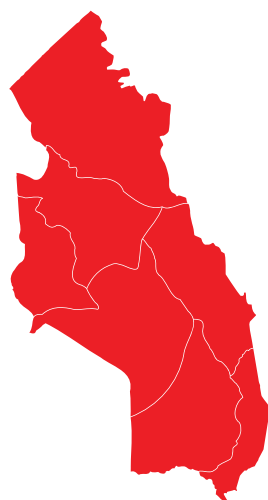

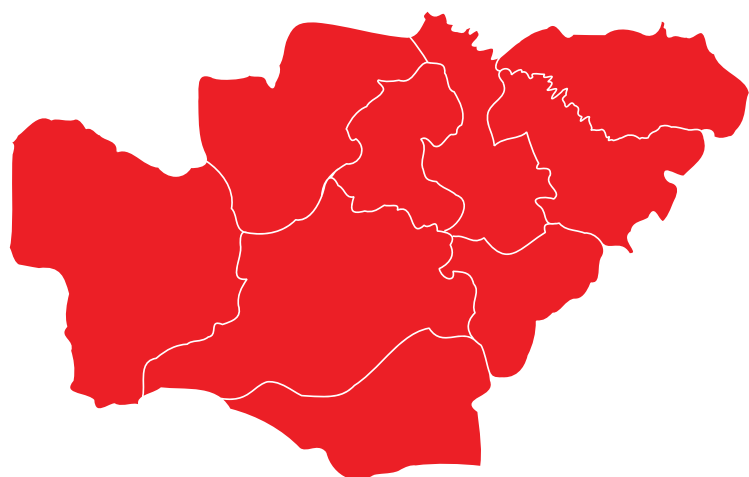
Figure 6.10: Directly elected incumbent MPs in Kigezi who voted for removal of age limit and ran for re-election in 2021.

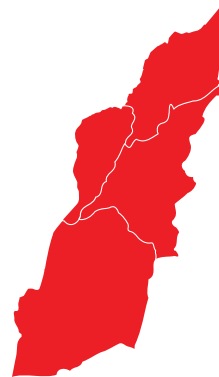

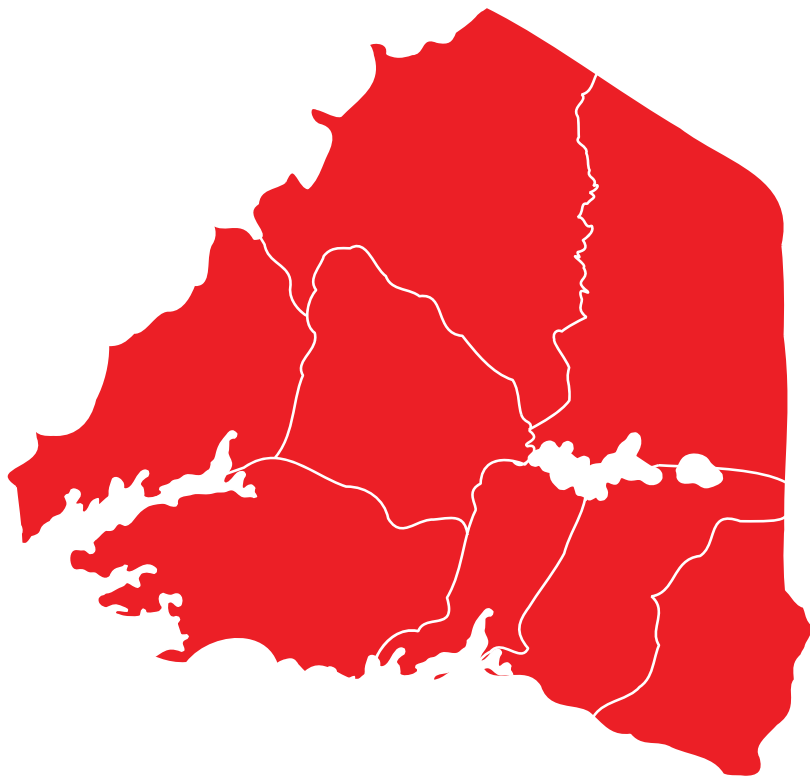
Figure 6.13: Directly elected incumbent MPs in Rwenzori who voted for removal of age limit and ran for re-election in 2021.

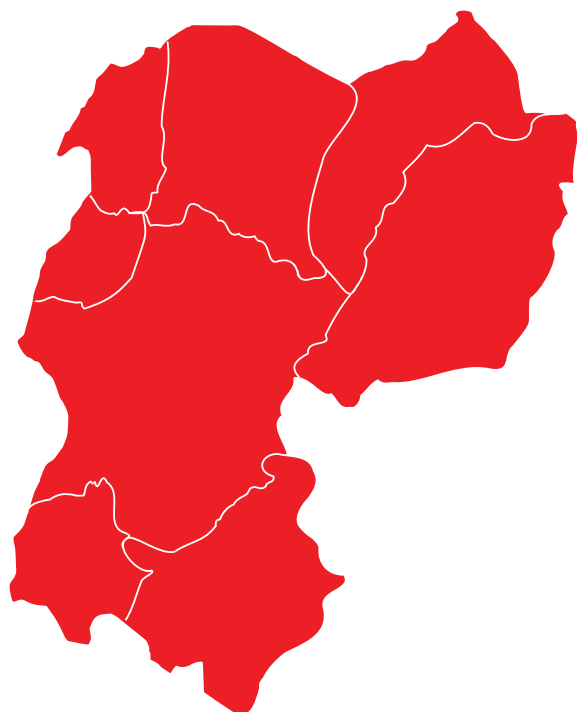
Figure 6.15: Directly elected incumbent MPs in Tooro who voted for removal of age limit and ran for re-election in 2021.

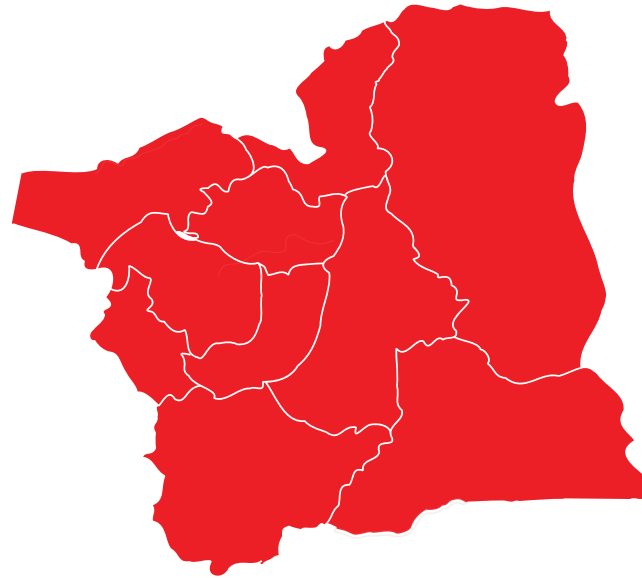

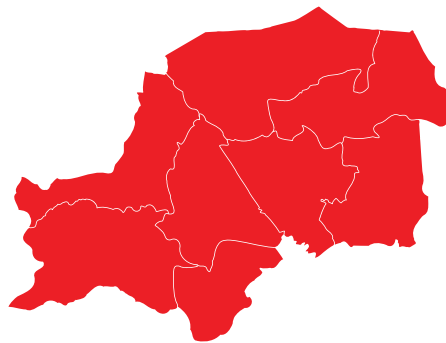


Figure 7.1: Incumbent district women representatives in Ankole who voted for removal of age limit and ran for re-election in 2021.



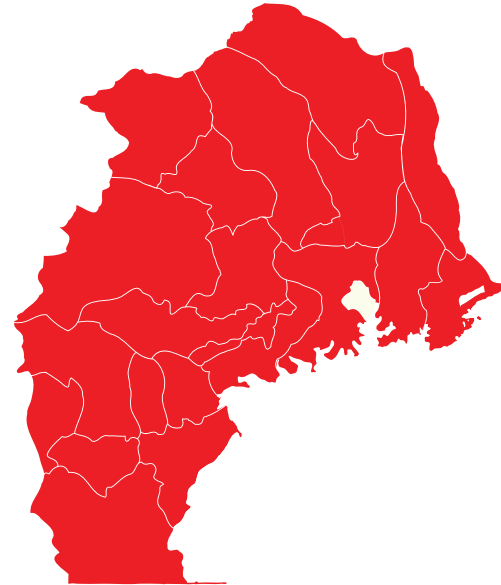

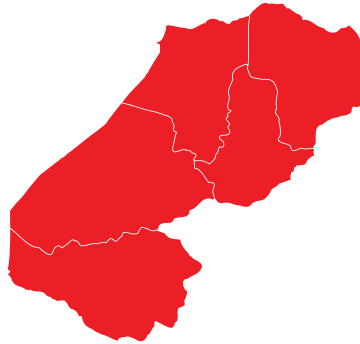

Figure 7.5: Incumbent district women representatives in Bugisu who voted for removal of age limit and ran for re-election in 2021.



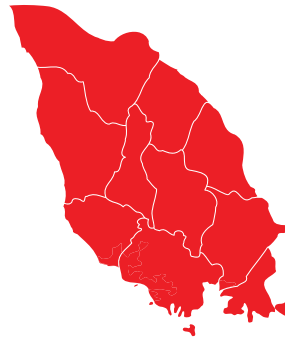

Figure 7.6: Incumbent district women representatives in Bunyoro who voted for removal of age limit and ran for re-election in 2021.



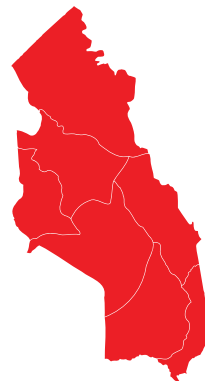

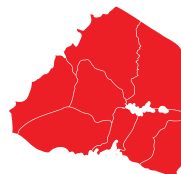

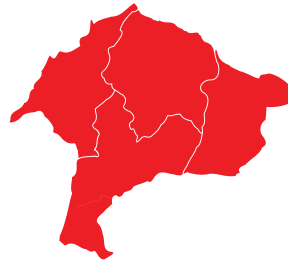

Figure 7.13: Incumbent district women representatives in Sebei who voted for removal of age limit and ran for re-election in 2021.



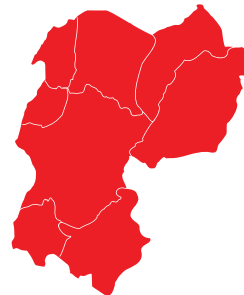

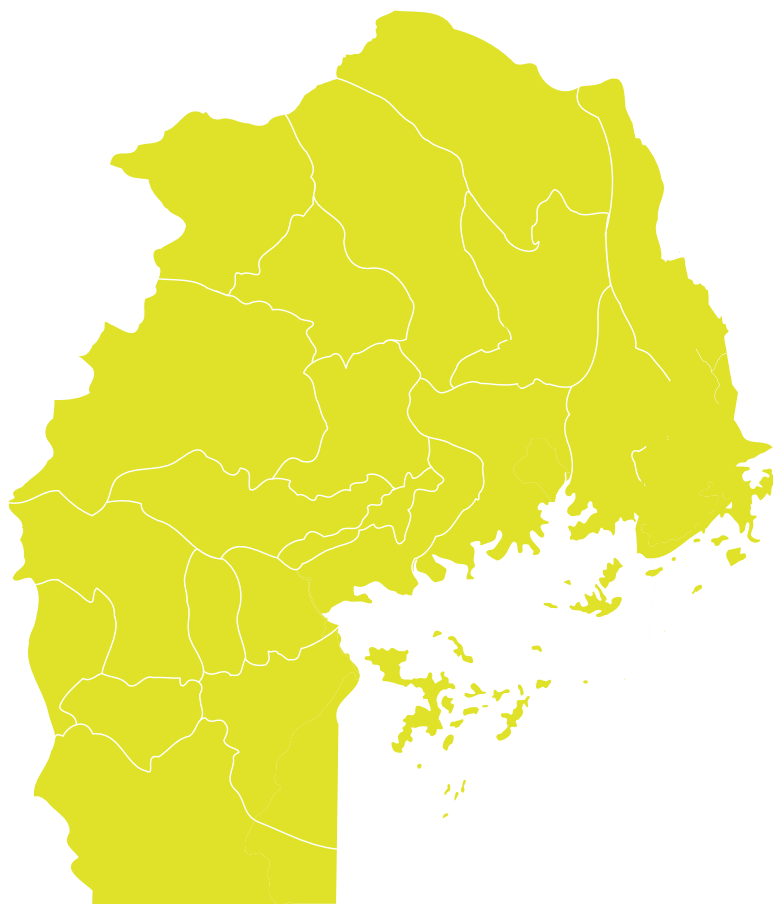

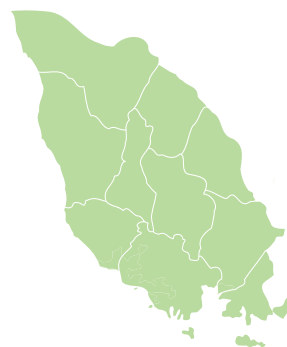

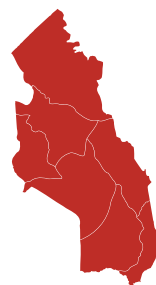

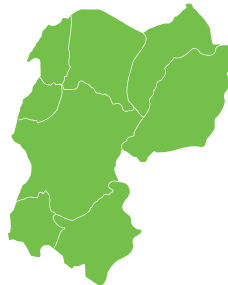

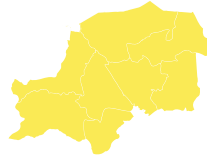

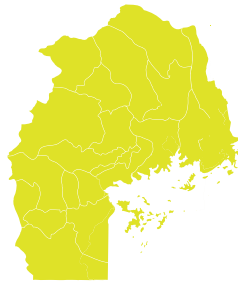

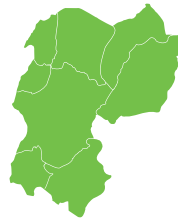
